Věra Stojarová, in her lecture (realized in English), covered all the goals she formulated at the beginning of the lecture. She first presented the basic theoretical background of the far right concept, including terminological problems with this concept. In addition, this concept was applied to the political parties of the Balkan countries. Dr. Stojarová focused on ideological characteristics of these parties, their internal organization and party leadership, strategies and tactics, voters and finally legislative implementation in practice. She illustrated her analysis on examples from individual Balkan countries.

Speech by dr. Stojarová was didactically high-level, accessible to the wider audience, while fully professional. The lecture took place within a specified time scale.

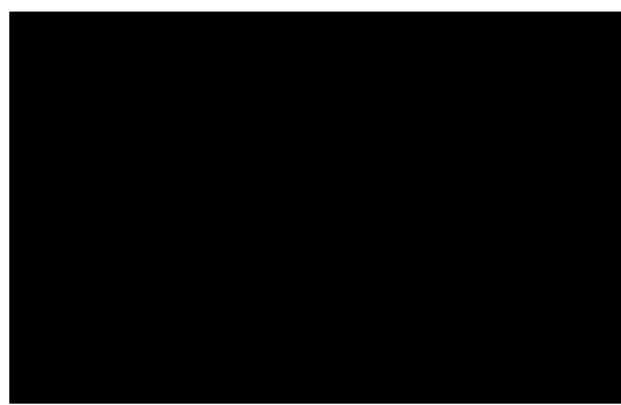
At the end of the lecture, the lecturer responded promptly to the questions asked, such as the problem of the influence of the ICTFY on the popularity of far right parties, the positionality of Serbian Progressive Party, the pan-Slavic tendencies in far right parties as well as the political future of these parties.
