SEMESTER (TERM) ENROLMENT

• Don't forget to do the term enrolment for the following semester if you have at least 20 credits. It is not being done automatically in the information system, you have do it in IS.

PRIOR DEGREE RECOGNITION

Required for all NEW Full Degree Students

According to Czech law, all full degree students must have their prior degrees recognized in order to study in a degree program in the Czech Republic. FSS students can submit this recognition to Ludmila Polášková when they arrive, however they should be sure to have all the necessary paperwork with them from their home country.

GRADUATION

Graduation ceremony traditionally takes place about 2 months after the state exams. An email will come from the Study Office to sign up for graduation. The graduation dates are as follows

- January state exams: March 21 and 22
- May/June state exams: 1st week in September

LANGUAGE AND SPORTS CLASSES

Open to FSS Full degree and exchange students

Full degree students are also able to enroll in free French and Spanish introductory language courses taught in English. Other <u>language courses</u> are offered at the Language Centre in Italian, Swahili, German, and Czech, however there is a fee for these courses.

ERASMUS+ APPLICATIONS FOR 2024/2025.

Applications for the European Erasmus exchange study stays are currently open.

The application deadline is 17-19 February based on the conditions of the Department. Detailed information on how to apply will come from the departmental coordinators - the list of coordinators is on the next page. More information can be found on our <u>website</u>.

Quick Reminder - Registration and Enrollment are separate actions

- Registration: The registration period determines the interest of students in courses. Students can obtain better time stamps for capacity-limited courses.
- Enrollment: During this period there is an automatic enrollment / confirmation of subjects for which enrollment conditions have been met (capacity, prerequisites, etc.). Only at the moment of enrollment do you acquire the right and obligation to study the course.

THE MUNICIPAL WASTE FEE IN BRNO IN 2024

INFORMATION FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Since 1/1/2013 the local fees for municipal waste in Brno have had to be paid for by:

• all foreign nationals (both EU and non-EU) residing in Brno for longer than 3 months

The fee is to be paid for by each person.

The above mentioned fee payers are obliged to:

- 1. pay for the fee in due time (if the fee is not paid for in due time, it may be increased up to three times the fee)
- 2. to report this fact to the fee administrator (electronic forms are available at www.brno.cz/odpady); failing the reporting duty may result in a fine imposed by the fee administrator. In the administration of tax all meetings are to be conducted and all documents are to be produced in Czech.

FEE RATE 670 CZK per payer for the calendar year 2024 - FEE TO BE PAID BY 31/5/2024

You can make the payment from January already. Concerning a duty to pay the fee arising in the period from 1/5 to 31/12, a proportionate part of the fee is payable by the last day of the month following the month in which the duty to pay the fee arose.

ACCOUNT NUMBER

• You will be required to pay a fine up to three times the yearly fee; failure to pay can be enforced by the seizure of your property.
