# FALL SEMESTER DATES

## ✓ Before the Semester Starts

- **Apply for term enrolment:**  
 *May 19 – September 22, 2025*  
(Required step to continue your studies!)
- **Pay fees & complete online registration:**  
Do this as soon as possible to activate your student status!
- **Course registration (pick your courses):**  
 *June 30, 2025 (17:00) – September 1, 2025*  
You can register even if your study isn't active yet – just make sure to complete it later!
- **Course enrolment (system confirms your registered courses):**  
 *September 2 (17:00) – September 14, 2025*
- **Course changes (add/drop classes):**  
 *September 15 – September 28, 2025*
- **Seminar group enrolment (for courses with seminars):**  
 *September 2 (17:00) – September 28, 2025*
- **Timetable available:**  
 *August 29, 2025*

## REMINDER: ENROLL AND REGISTER FOR THE UPCOMING SEMESTER

During the summer holidays, don't forget to enroll for the upcoming semester and register for courses using the IS. Check the dates for the next academic year [on the webpage](#).

### Quick Reminder - Registration and Enrollment are separate actions

- **Registration:** The registration period determines the interest of students in courses. Students can obtain better time stamps for capacity-limited courses.
- **Enrollment:** During this period there is an automatic enrollment / confirmation of subjects for which enrollment conditions have been met (capacity, prerequisites, etc.). Only at the moment of enrollment do you acquire the right and obligation to study the course.



# TIPS

## Document validity tracker

Renewing your visa or residence permit is stressful – that anxious voice at the back of your head telling you that you might have missed something is all too familiar. A new tool on the Information Portal for Foreigners can help ease that worry.

With the document validity tracker, you can save your passport or residence permit in your personal profile and receive an automatic email reminder 90 days before it expires.

'Purpose of seeking employment' visas allows you to stay in the Czech Republic for up to 9 months to find a job and transition to a work visa.

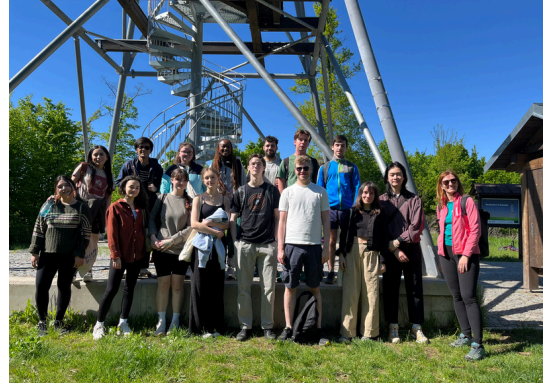

Main concert day (19 July) features Tata Bojs, Richard Müller, Emma Smetana & Jordan Haj, and others – with free entry.

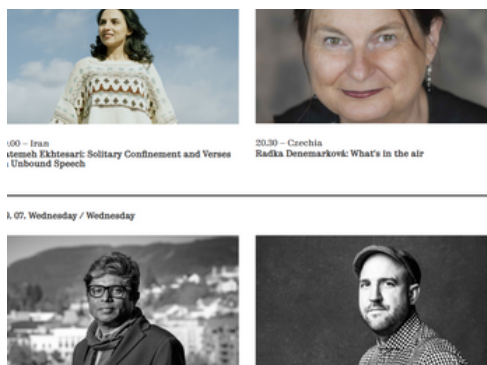
Also includes lectures, family activities, and special tours at the Augustinian Abbey.

# BRNO SWIMMING POOLS

## Where to go swimming?

Brno Reservoir (Brněnská přehrada) is located on the outskirts of the city and is a popular destination for swimming. It offers several designated swimming areas, sandy beaches, and clear water. There are also water sports facilities and boat rentals available.



Riviera Swimming Pool (Riviera bazén) is an outdoor pool complex situated along the River Svatka. It features multiple pools, including an Olympic-sized pool, water slides, and various water attractions. It's a great place to cool off and have fun with friends and family.

Kraví Hora Swimming Pool (Koupaliště Kraví Hora) is a large outdoor pool complex situated on Kraví Hora hill. It offers multiple pools, including a diving pool and a children's pool. The facility also has spacious green areas for sunbathing and picnicking.



Dobrovského Pool (Dobrovského koupaliště) is an outdoor swimming complex and it offers a large swimming pool with both shallow and deep areas, making it suitable for swimmers of all levels. The pool is surrounded by a spacious grassy area. There are also facilities for beach volleyball and other recreational activities.



# TIPS FOR SUMMER TRIPS

## Moravian Karst

Explore the Moravian Karst, a picturesque karst landscape with an extensive cave system. Visit the famous Macocha Abyss and Punkva Caves, and take a boat ride, check [this link](#) in order to buy the tickets online.

- The Sloup-Šošůvka Caves are an impressive cave system known for its unique formations and underground waterfalls.
- The Kateřinská Cave is the longest cave in the Moravian Karst and offers a fascinating underground journey.
- The Sloupsko-Šošůvské Caves are a complex of interconnected caves. Visitors can admire the delicate dripstone formations, underground lakes, and the famous spectacular natural limestone barrier.

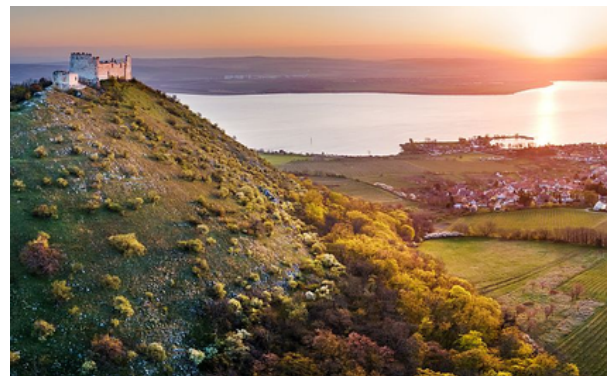


## Lednice-Valtice Cultural Landscape

Discover the UNESCO-listed Lednice-Valtice area, known for its stunning chateaux, picturesque landscapes, and beautiful gardens. Take a boat ride on the serene artificial lake and explore the romantic architecture of the area. The town Valtice is home to the magnificent Valtice Chateau which showcases exquisite Baroque architecture and houses impressive art collections and a wine museum.

## Pálava hills

Experience the natural beauty of the Pálava Hills, a protected landscape area. Hike through the rolling vineyard-covered hills, visit the medieval castle ruins of Děvičky, and enjoy panoramic views from the top of the Svatý Kopeček Hill.





# TIPS FOR SUMMER TRIPS

## Telč

Discover the charming town of Telč, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Admire the well-preserved Renaissance architecture, particularly the colorful houses surrounding the main square, and visit the beautiful Telč Castle. You can also check the MUNI premises and even [accommodation here](#).



## Olomouc

Visit the historical city of Olomouc, famous for its impressive Holy Trinity Column, charming squares, and vibrant baroque architecture. Take advantage of the astronomical clock and the stunning St. Wenceslas Cathedral. Olomouc is only 1 hour from Brno; taking a bus or train is easy. The center is not very big, and you can see the main points of interest in a day. Take advantage of the park near the university center!

## Znojmo

Visit the historical town of Znojmo, known for its medieval architecture and wine production. Explore the underground tunnels of the Znojmo Catacombs, enjoy wine tasting, and admire the panoramic views from Znojmo Castle. You can also visit the Znojmo Underground to see medieval tunnels and cellars. Take the chance to try the famous Znojmo wines and pickles. Znojmo hosts lively festivals, like the [Znojenské Vinobraní wine festival](#), starting on 13-15th September 2024.
