REMINDER: ENROLL AND REGISTER FOR THE SEMESTER AND COURSES

Course enrollment is from 2 September to 14 September and changes to your courses can take place between 15 - 28 September 2025. **Changes cannot take place after this date.**

Quick Reminder - Registration and Enrollment are separate actions

- Registration: The registration period determines the interest of students in courses. Students can obtain better time stamps for capacity-limited courses.
- Enrollment: During this period there is an automatic enrollment / confirmation of subjects for which enrollment conditions have been met (capacity, prerequisites, etc.). Only at the moment of enrollment do you acquire the right and obligation to study the course.

ISIC CARDS

Renewing and purchasing.

Returning students are required to extend the validity of the MU ISIC card online via digital revalidation. You can make an application at MU [Shopping center](#), where you will also find the current price for extending your card validity. It is called "[Digitální revalidace karty ISIC pro rok 2025/2026](#)" and it costs 250 CZK. The validity of your digital card will automatically change in the Alive App after successful payment and registration in the database. The ISIC licence on your plastic card will not be visibly extended. You can continue to use your plastic card within the university.



New students are asked to [upload their picture](#) or [schedule their photographing at MUNI](#), however they would have needed to purchase the ISIC card for 250 CZK, it is called "[Průkaz ISIC – první průkaz \(prezenční studium\) na Fakultě sociálních studií](#)"

Exchange/Erasmus students received a link from Dagmar Hábová and please take into consideration that the price for Exchange students is 450 CZK.

PRIOR DEGREE RECOGNITION

Required for all NEW Full Degree Students

According to Czech law, all full degree students must have their prior degrees recognized in order to study in a degree program in the Czech Republic. FSS students can submit this recognition to Ludmila Polášková when they arrive, however they should be sure to have all the necessary paperwork with them from their home country.
