#### **Grading**

At Masaryk University, the ECTS grading system is used. The **number** of ECTS credits for each course reflects the total number of hours a student is expected to devote to the course per semester (in the form of lectures, homework, reading, essays, consultations, etc.

A,B,C,D,E - in graded courses = passed

F,X - in graded courses = fail

P, Z - in non-graded courses = passed

N - in non-graded courses = fail




