CALL FOR ONE EXPERT to take part in the approved project HousErasmus+ (Erasmus+, KA3 – support for policy reform) which is related to the impact of housing and affordable accommodation on Erasmus and international student and trainee in Europe.

#### Details of the project:

<b>Type</b>	Erasmus+, KA3, EACEA-33-2014
<b>Title</b>	HousErasmus+
<b>Length</b>	Minimum 6 months, starting in January 2016
<b>Short description</b>	<p>The aims of the call are to select an expert who works fulltime for six months minimum on two main tasks: a desk research, creating and monitoring a survey and run two study visits.</p> <p>The desk research will consist of a literature review to identify countries/universities/regions in Europe with important problems or innovative solutions about housing and accommodation for students and trainees.</p> <p>The desk research will produce a comprehensive overview on where the issues in the housing market are most pressing and reform or change is needed. The most up-to date information on housing for international students and trainees will be also analysed.</p> <p>The work on the survey will consist of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Creating the survey</li><li>2. Dissemination the survey to the target group using as many channels as possible and with the support of the other project partners.</li><li>3. Constant follow-up and monitoring of the results throughout the dissemination period and a final analysis report of the survey. Reporting will be expected during the dissemination.</li></ol> <p>The survey will target to International Relations Offices and</p>

	<p>Erasmus coordinators at European universities. The survey must dig deep on the role of universities on supporting Erasmus students and the main gaps, challenges and practices at their universities and at their regional/national stage.</p> <p>The expert will be in charge of organizing and reporting two study visits, to be determined and designed by the projects' management team.</p>
<b>Area where the project is to be implemented</b>	Europe
<b>Role of the CGU in the project</b>	Full partner of the project and member of the management team
<b>The CGU searches an expert under the following terms</b>	<p>Field of studies: Professor of social sciences or alike or a lecturer with experience in international mobility; or student of PhD with experience on research and management of qualitative/quantitative data.</p> <p>The expert must be proficiency in English. Other EU languages will be an asset.</p> <p>The selection of the expert will be made by the CGU according to its internal rules and the European Commission and Spanish Law formal and legal regulations.</p>
<b>Number of experts needed</b>	One expert
<b>Home country of the needed expert</b>	Any EU country with flexibility to travel.
<b>Details of the tasks to be carried out</b>	<p>To map out the current situation of accommodation market for international students and trainees around Europe; through the review of all literature in this field, focusing mainly on English sources. To create, manage and analyse a survey to International Relations Officers about international students' housing and accommodation.</p> <p>At least three reports must be produced for each task.</p>
<b>Economic compensation</b>	Yes, considered in the project's budget a gross salary of 35,000 Euro, including all mandatory taxes. The expert will be offered a fulltime employment contract for 6 months minimum under the Spanish Regulations.
